## From the Pastor's Cluttered Desk

Spring is now officially here and I'm glad it is. Farmers are ready to get to work in the fields; work has been delayed by wet, cold weather long enough. Those of you who enjoy getting out in a garden are ready to get busy planting. The ice of recent weeks has brought down an abundance of limbs, pine cones, trees, and other things that need to be cleaned up from the yard. With flowers already in bloom and birds looking for a place to build a nest, it sounds almost too good to be true. Yes, I know, those of us that suffer from pollen will dread to see everything being covered in yellow. Get out the tissues!

With all of the evidence of new life around us, we are reminded that there are still so many things that disturb us. Martin Luther wrote these words in a hymn, "Pain and decay in all I see. . ." Each time we turn on the news or open the paper we see the hard evidence of just how true that is. A scaffold collapses in downtown Raleigh and three workers are killed. In France yet another plane crashes and

early reports are that everyone on board is dead. Fighting continues unabated in far too many places. Some of the fighting is with lethal weapons, some of it is political and ideological, but gruesome none the less.

In Romans 8 the Apostle Paul writes of "the sufferings of this present time." In too many ways we act as if Jesus were still sealed securely in the tomb." Where is the hope that Paul spoke of in 2 Corinthians 5:17-18. "So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation."

Easter preaching is difficult; the resurrection is about a living God that is determined to make all things new. There is a fight going on between good and evil! Satan is just as determined as he has ever been to destroy everything good that he can. The good news is that God will not be defeated, not by the enemy, nor death, nor principalities and powers, not even by the church itself. Easter is a reminder to us that we are the ones that must change and join God in His plan or remain under the influence of the

world and sin and death.

Jesus identified Himself to His disciples by His wounds. It was a reminder of the words of Isaiah, "By His wounds we are healed." Little wonder Paul could say, "Death has been swallowed up in victory, Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" (I Corinthians 15:54-55)

Our Easter Sunday schedule will be a little different this year; we will begin with a Sunrise Service at 7:00 a.m., followed by breakfast at 7:30 a.m. Sunday School will be at 8:30 a.m. and our Worship Service and Easter Cantata at 9:30 a.m. Please help us out by letting family and friends know about these changes!

Our Easter Egg Hunt for children will be at the Peter's Creek community building on Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. Lunch will be served. 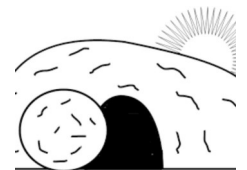
