From the Pastor's Cluttered Desk

Most churches suffer from a problem of language limitations: we are too busy, we are aging, there are too few people, we are tired, we keep doing the same things over and over until they become boring and meaningless. We forget that the Gospel is Good News, not an endless list of thou shalt nots. The challenges we face are issues of spiritual discernment. In Joel 2:28-29, God promised to pour out His Spirit on ALL flesh: sons and daughters, old men and young, male and female.
