From the Pastor's Cluttered Desk,

Recently I read an article that spoke of the increasing number of people in our society that have become incredibly self-centered. The article spoke of how many have become focused on their own views, their needs, their wants, their opinions, and in turn, tune out the views of those around them. That sounds like very childish behavior! On further reflection I thought of the words of a hymn, "Help me to live for others, that I might live like Thee."

Velma Wallis has written a book entitled Two Old Women that tells of an Alaskan Athabaskan legend of two old women. The tribe was on the verge of starvation and realized that if they were to survive they would need to move from their current location. They knew the move would be difficult at best, and that taking the elderly would prove to be an added burden. There were two elderly women in the tribe that had no extended family. In addition, the two women had spent much of their later years griping and complaining about almost everything. Needless to say the other members of the tribe found them difficult to get along with

and they certainly were not team players. A decision was made to leave the two women behind and move to a new location in a search of food and survival. Having been left behind, the two women began to see how much the other members of the tribe had done for them, and also how demanding and unbearable they had become. Since there was no one left to meet their demands and care for them, they began to meet their own needs. In time the tribe and the two women were reunited and reconciliation began to take place.

If you have some time to spend reading and reflecting during these cold days, I recommend the book to you for consideration. It is a reminder to us that almost every family has a crazy uncle or an unbearable aunt that suffers ailments. Did you watch the *Griswold Family Christmas* rerun this year? While it is intended as a comedy, it has enough reality to make you want to cry.

Beginning on March 4th we will begin a short study of Ezekiel on Wednesday nights. If you have time, read over the book and think of the painful situation the people of Israel found themselves in as they were carried off into captivity. God used a foreign nation to discipline His chosen people. The prophet saw a valley of dismembered dry

bones that were reassembled and brought back to life by the breath of God.

Easter is a reminder to us that God still gives the promise to speak and bring life, even in a cemetery. The Spirit can also move and bring life to a spiritually dead heart. Pray that we will be God-centered and not self-centered as we move through the season of Lent.
