YOUTH NEWS !

Our youth meet every Wednesday night in the Fellowship Hall. Brooke started in January going through the Bible beginning with Genesis. She has finished 6 books and started the book of Judges in July. We have Bible Study each Wednesday night with the exception of the monthly Conf/Mtg. night, and she has a fun night planned for them. This month we went swimming at the Weathington's pool. In addition to our Bible Study, we are very busy with our other activities. Every Friday, we delivery 15-20 meals to the sick and shut-in's in the community. It is as much of a blessing for our youth as it is for the one's we are visiting.

Our Summer Mission Project this year was on Saturday, June 17th . We met at the fellowship hall for a pancake breakfast and started out project right here in Beaver Dam. We traveled just across the road to Mrs. Brenda Hales home. 20 plus youth and adults pulled weeds, mowed grass, sprayed roundup and insecticide, dug up several huge stumps with tractors, raked the yard, made 2 mixed flower pots, planted flowers in the yard, power washed the house and the driveway, cleaned the garage and put out 12 bales of pine straw. After a nice hot lunch at the fellowship hall, we went to Mr. & Mrs. Jake Vinson's house and picked up limbs, power washed walkways, leveled out his fountain and patio tables, and raked about 8 trailer loads of pine straw and leaves. After a very hot and tiring day, finished off the day with pizza and went to the pool at the Weathington's.

We are planning another clean up day in the fall for our youth.
