## IT'S ON MY HEART

### *“The Disciples just didn't get it”*

In reading over this week's Sunday School lesson I was drawn to John 20: 8-9: “Then went in also the other disciple, which came to the Sepulcher, and he saw, and believed. For as yet they did not know (understand) the scripture that He must rise again from the dead.”

Matthew's account tells us that on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early only to discover that the stone was rolled away and Jesus was gone. She rushed back to tell Peter and the other disciples that His body had been stolen. So Peter and John ran to the tomb to find that it indeed was empty, but upon looking more closely Peter took note of how undisturbed the tomb looked. The napkins that had been placed upon the body were neatly folded with the one from His head folded and it a place by itself. Luke 24:12 relates that Peter marveled at seeing the sepulcher in such good order; meaning by this, that Peter thought of something greater and loftier than what Mary had told him, that the body of Jesus had been stolen.

“Then went in also the other disciple, which came to the Sepulcher, and he saw, and believed. For as yet they did not know (*or understand*) the scripture that He must rise again from the dead.” (John 20: 9)

As one commentator says, “The disciples just didn't get it”. Jesus had told them earlier “...that He must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life” ( Matthew 16:21, also in Matthew 20: 17-19.) Still somehow they just didn't get it, but now it comes back to them at the empty tomb, and they remember what He said, they now understand, now they get it. “This is what He told us beforehand”, they must have mused to one another. They now believed, there was living proof.
