FROM THE PASTOR

DON'T OVERLOOK THE POSSIBILITIES

SCRIPTURE

John 6:9 (KJV): ⁹There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but **what are they among so many?**

John 6:12-13 (KJV): ¹²When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost. ¹³Therefore they gathered *them* together, and **filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves**, which remained **over and above** unto them that had eaten.

I like the story found in the Gospel of John which tells of Jesus feeding the hungry crowd with the lunch of a little boy. Do you identify more with the disciples in this story or with Jesus? The disciples focused more on the PROBLEM; Jesus focused on the SOLUTION. The disciples asked, “*What are they* (referring to the five barley loaves and two fishes) *among so many* (a crowd in excess of 5,000 people)?” Where they saw *impossibilities*, Jesus saw *possibilities*.

Too often, we underestimate the power of God to turn seemingly *impossibilities* into sure *possibilities*. When it comes to the future of **Beaver Dam Baptist Church**, let's not overlook the possibilities. **With God, all things are possible!**
